Donor Advisor for a Day Awards \$10,200 In 2009, a community-minded group of area women joined together to make their vision become a reality. Women Who Care held its first meeting on October 8, 2009 with 100 women in attendance. Since then the organization has become well known in Elk County as a dedicated philanthropic women's giving circle that generously funds worthy projects of non-profit organizations that benefit women and their families.

Through the pooled funds of the many members who donate to WWC each year, they organization awards grants at their annual meeting to eligible 501c3 organizations. Area nonprofits are invited to apply for funding through an annual competitive grants process. WWC grant applications are available on our website or by contacting the Foundation. Grant recipients are voted on by our membership at our annual meeting.


